Reach every lesson on time. Arrival at all lessons must be within the first five minutes of the starting time. Walk to lessons in a CALM and PURPOSEFUL way. Always make sure you are a Role Model to others.





Enter the lesson quietly and calmly when invited in by the teacher. Sit down as per the seating plan. Ensure you have the correct equipment and open your books or folders ready to start learning.





Attention is directed to the teacher, and the instructions given about the Intended Learning for the lesson. The teacher will Activate Learning by asking you to recall prior knowledge and reflect on your previous learning.





Demonstrate that you are ambitious to learn by having a positive attitude when completing all tasks. You will need to stay determined to learn and to succeed. Make every effort to succeed and strive for excellence.





You always show respect by listening to your teacher and your peers, and by being polite. Learn with and from others whenever you are asked to do so. Look for every opportunity to practise so that you develop independence

Preparing for life by finding the best in everyone


