RE: GCSE Results - Thursday 12th August 2021

We are now in the position to explain the process for your son/daughter to receive their GCSE results. To ensure the safety of all students and staff, we do not feel that it would be appropriate to bring students, staff or parents into the Academy to receive GCSE or A-level results. Therefore we will be sending out the results via our e-mail system.

Your son/daughter will receive their GCSE results on Thursday 12th August. These will be sent to their **school e-mail account** from 10am. Following this, they will receive further e-mails with a range of details and information including:

- An e-mail from Mr Lewis and Mr Anderson about Sixth Form places (if they have applied).
- An e-mail from the Exams office about sitting exams in the Autumn Series and other key examination information.

If your child need support to access your school e-mail, they should refer to the instructions on the school website.

Please ensure that you and your child do not come into the Academy on results day unless they have been asked to attend an appointment with a member of the Sixth Form team. Please make sure however, that we are able to speak to your child on results days – keeping both Thursday 12th and Friday 13th August free, just in case they need to come to the Academy for a meeting.

I know that some of you may be worried about the grades that your child is likely to achieve but please remember that teachers are **not able to give you any information** about the grades that will be awarded this summer.

If your son/daughter do not believe their grade is reflective of the evidence they provided, they do have the opportunity to appeal. Details of appeals and the steps that they will need to take will be sent out before 16th July 2021, with full information also available on the Teacher Assessed Grades section of the Academy website.

I would like to take this opportunity to wish your son/daughter all the best for their results in the summer and the very best wishes for whatever their future holds. We look forward to welcoming many of our students back to QKA Sixth Form in September and continuing to work with you to support their future plans.
