Temporary closure for Year 9 to move to remote learning- Monday 17th January 2022 up to and including Wednesday 19th January 2022

Like many schools across the country, we are currently facing low staffing levels and are aware that this will continue at least over the next few days. We have therefore made the decision to move to remote learning for year 9 for the next couple of school days in the interest of our students' safety and wellbeing.

This blended learning approach is very important, as it will allow all year groups to receive a mixture of face-to-face and remote learning, ensuring that the measures we need to put in place are fair for all students.
