

**Immersion courses in France, Spain and Germany for members of
The Association for Language Learning (ALL)
“Exploring and Developing CLIL”
2020 - 2021**

LFEE Europe has been running immersion courses in Europe under the Erasmus+ programme since 2002. ALL is the membership association for Language teaching professionals in England, Wales and Northern Ireland.

ALL and LFEE Europe have been working together on a 2 year project called ELAPSE (Embedding Languages Across the Primary and Secondary Education). ELAPSE aims to develop primary and secondary language teachers' awareness of the CLIL approach which is especially relevant in the current context of developing ambitious curricular aspirations. Practical resources and a good practice guide are being developed transnationally in French, German, Spanish and English. The focus is on the transition between Primary and Secondary phases.

To complement our work with the ELAPSE project, we propose to offer a training programme in France, Germany and Spain. This one week course is available to Primary and Secondary teachers and aims to:

- Explore strategies for extending learners' language skills through Interdisciplinary activities
- Develop new skills for language teaching and transferability across subject area
- Explore the CLIL approach and see how to Plan a CLIL lesson
- Join in practical CLIL workshops
- Develop and consolidate participants' knowledge of French / Spanish / German
- Increase participants' cultural awareness of France/Spain/Germany
- Explore efficient and innovative use of ICT tools
- See CLIL in action during a possible school visit (depending on time of year and availability of our partners)

Course dates

- Saturday 24 - Saturday 31 October 2020, Montpellier, France.
- Saturday 10 - Saturday 17 April 2021, Malaga, Spain and Berlin, Germany.
- Saturday 17 - Saturday 24 July 2021, Montpellier, France and Malaga, Spain.

Funding for all our courses is available through the **European Union Erasmus+ Programme** and covers the cost of the tuition fee, accommodation, subsistence and travel costs. ALL will be applying for Erasmus+ funding on behalf of all applicants.
