Dear Parents and Carers,

We are sure that you are aware that the British government wants every child back in school in early September. Likewise, so do all of us at Thomas Deacon Education Trust.

However, we also want our parents, carers and families to know that we intend to do everything in our power to keep children and staff (and consequently our communities) safe from the virus.

This means big changes to the way we have organised our academies previously. 'Bubbles' may need to arrive and depart from school at different times as children from all year groups cannot come to school or leave school at the same time. It may mean that we have a staggered start to the year. This is due to the virus and not because we do not want to have all the children back.

The government safety measures will affect our school day working patterns and as soon as possible, each Principal/Headteacher will let you know what those arrangements might look like for your child.


