Dear Parents and Carers

Temporary closure of Year 8 (Mon – Weds) and Year 10 (Thurs-Fri)

In yesterday's letter, we explained to you that like many schools across the country we are currently facing low staffing levels. We are now aware that this is likely to continue next week and we have had to make further decisions today in the interest of our students' safety and wellbeing.

I want to be clear again that this is not because of any positive cases of Covid-19 in the academy and under normal circumstances, staff absences rarely cause problems and can be quickly solved. However, under the current circumstances, schools are facing significant challenges with staff absences much higher than normal.

Next week, we will unfortunately need to ask all students in Year 8 to remain at home from Monday 9th November to Wednesday 11th November and all students in Year 10 to remain at home on Thursday 12th November and Friday 13th November.

This blended approach for Year 8 and Year 10 is very important as it will allow both year groups to receive a mixture of face to face and remote learning, ensuring that the measures we need to put in place are fair for all students.

During their time at home, work for students in Year 8 and 10 will be set on Microsoft Teams.
