Dear Parents and Carers

Temporary closure of Year 7 (Mon - Wed) and Post 16 (Thurs-Fri)

As previously explained in my letter on 6 November, like many schools across the country we are currently facing low staffing levels. We are now aware that this will continue next week and we have had to make further decisions today in the interest of our students' safety and wellbeing.

I want to be clear again that this is not as a result of positive cases of Covid-19 in the academy and under normal circumstances, staff absences rarely cause problems and can be quickly solved. However, under the current circumstances, schools are facing significant challenges with staff absences much higher than normal.

Next week, we will unfortunately need to ask all students in Year 7 to remain at home from Monday 16th November to Wednesday 18th November and all students in Post 16 to remain at home on Thursday 19th November and Friday 20th November.

This blended approach for Year 7 and Post 16 is very important as it will allow both year groups to receive a mixture of face to face and remote learning, ensuring that the measures we need to put in place are fair for all students.

During their time at home, work for students in Year 7 and Post 16 will be set on Microsoft Teams.
