Dear Parents and Carers

Temporary closure of Year 9 (Mon – Wed 23rd-25th November) and Year 8 (Thurs-Fri 26th-27th November)

As previously explained, like many schools across the country we are currently facing low staffing levels. We are now aware that this will continue next week and we have had to make further decisions today in the interest of our students' safety and wellbeing.

I want to be clear again that this is not as a result of positive cases of Covid-19 in the academy and under normal circumstances, staff absences rarely cause problems and can be quickly solved. However, under the current circumstances, schools are facing significant challenges with staff absences much higher than normal.

Next week, we will unfortunately need to ask all students in Year 9 to remain at home from Monday 23rd November to Wednesday 25th November and all students in Year 8 to remain at home on Thursday 26th November and Friday 27th November.

This blended approach for Year 9 and Year 8 is very important as it will allow both year groups to receive a mixture of face to face and remote learning, ensuring that the measures we need to put in place are fair for all students.

During their time at home, work for students in Year 9 and Year 8 will be set on Microsoft Teams.
